

## Inhaled medications for chronic obstructive pulmonary disorder (COPD)

The following medications are indicated for the treatment of COPD. The long-acting beta2-agonists (LABA) formoterol fumarate (Foradil®) and indacaterol (Onbrez®) were previously indicated but are no longer on the market in Canada.

<b>Inhaled corticosteroid (ICS)</b> Single-agent ICS products are NOT indicated as monotherapy for the treatment of COPD. However, these products may be used in tandem with a LABA, LAMA or LABA/LAMA combination product					
<b>Side effects of all ICS:</b> Oropharyngeal candidiasis and hoarseness, skin bruising, posterior subcapsular, nuclear cataracts, possible worsening of glaucoma. May decrease bone mineral density and increase fracture risk.
